

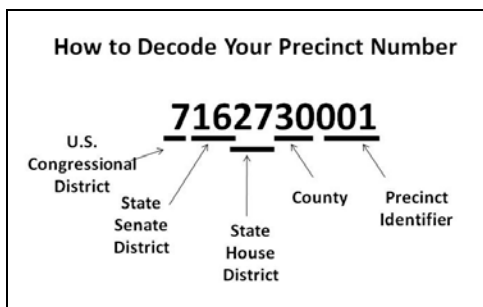
A Note from Peggy and Charli...

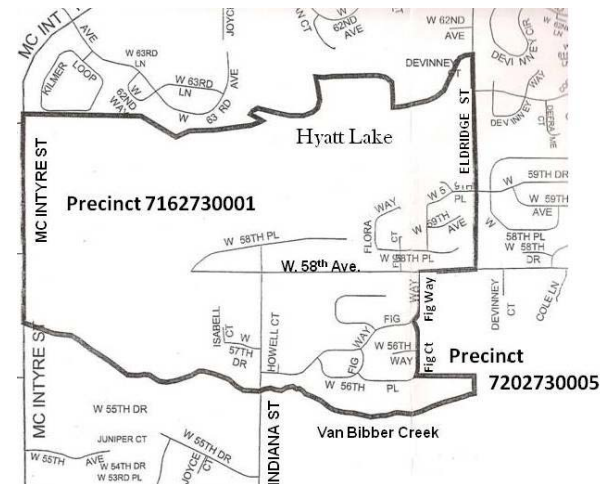
