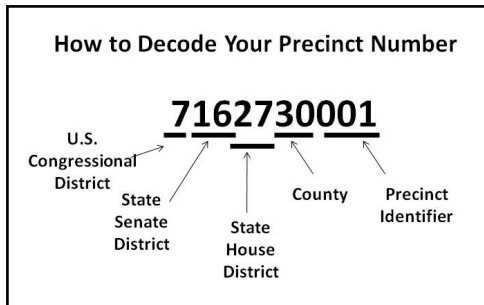
Vote by Mail or In-person.

Amendment P Transfers the licensing of games of chance from the Department of State to the Department of Revenue	Gambling
Amendment Q Process for moving the state seat to a temporary location during a declared disaster emergency	Admin of gov't
Amendment R Eliminates property taxes for individuals or businesses that use government-owned property for a private benefit	Taxes
Amendment 60 Proposes limiting how property taxes are raised and reversing recent tax laws which increased taxes	Taxes
Amendment 61 Forbids state borrowing and requires voter approval of local borrowing	State and local budgets
Amendment 62 Applies the term 'person' to every human being from the beginning of biological development	Abortion
Amendment 63 Protects the individual's right to make health care decisions	Health care
Proposition 101 Makes amendments to current vehicle, income and telecommunications taxes and fees	Taxes
Proposition 102 Amends the criteria for setting bail and type of bond	Law enforcement
