Primary Election

- Registration deadline is July 12.
- Register or check your registration details online at www.co.jefferson.co.us/elections
- In Jefferson County, registered voters will get their parties' Primary Ballots in the mail around July 22 – 27. Mail them back before Aug. 10.

Unaffiliated Voters

- If you edit your Voter Registration to change your party affiliation to REPUBLICAN you can vote in the GOP Primary. It's easy to do online at www.co.jefferson.co.us/elections.
- Change to GOP by Aug. 3 and Jeffco will mail you a GOP Primary Ballot. Do so Aug. 4 – 6, and pick up a ballot, e.g. at a Dept. of Motor Vehicles office.

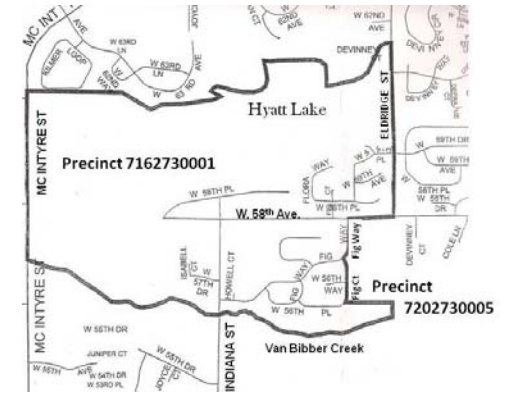
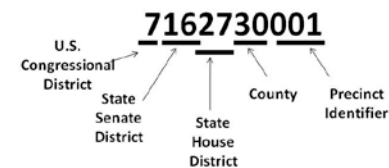
