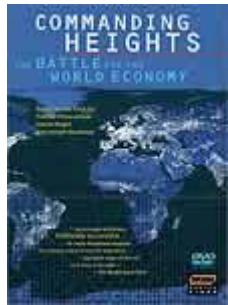
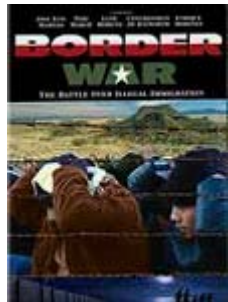

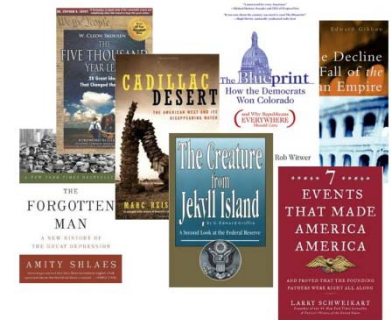
Border War: The Battle Over Illegal Immigration (2006)

Bossie, this provocative documentary chronicles the lives of five disparate people affected by the ongoing battle at the U.S.-Mexico border. Voices from the front lines include undocumented workers, open-border advocates, Hispanic-American "minutemen," U.S. border patrol agents and even a high-profile member of Congress.
